Pre-Modern (<- 1500)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • God & Scripture as authoritative • Science and religion work together in revealing reality
Modern (1500-1948)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Science & reason (naturalism) as authoritative • Elevate the capability of the human mind divorced from religion
Post-Modern (1948-present)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • From absolutes to relativism • From certainty to doubt and skepticism • There is no objective or universally applicable truth • Emphasis on experience (authenticity) • My truth


