Study the Bible

Jesus’ passion to rescue sinners has always generated a powerful reaction. Read through the following Scriptures and consider His motivation, His actions, and the reactions.

Luke 7:36-50

Luke 15:1-7

Jesus’ compassion towards sinners resulted in actions. Read the following verses and consider these questions: What did Jesus’ want for sinners and what did it cost Him?

John 17:13

Galatians 3:13-14

Hebrews 12:2

Discuss Together

Some would say one of the key reasons we don’t reach out is because of a lack of compassion. Is this true? If so, how does compassion relate to our fears about reaching?

Jesus’ compassion motivated Him to action. His desire was two-fold: to rescue us from the penalty of sin (God’s wrath) and to help us enter into the fullness of His joy.

How does this relate to our mission and us?

What might be the costs for being a “reaching” person? To be like Jesus, what must happen in us?

Read Hebrews 12:2 together. What did Jesus want? What should we want?
