In what ways does the Great Commission bring together the entire story of redemptive history? (God, Man, Sin, Jesus, Salvation)

Why should each of us get excited now about the things we will celebrate in eternity? How do we intentionally practice celebrating here on earth?

Take a look at Acts 28:22-24. What was Paul's response (this was the guy who was beaten, shipwrecked, stoned, whipped, wrote much of the New Testament even while in prison, and then gave up his life for Christ) to the global cause of God? Would taking a good beating because of your beliefs in Christ help or hurt your faith and why?

The theme for this year's Missions Celebration Weekend is, "Let's Do it Together!" What 2 or 3 people come to mind when you think about possibly getting involved in a mission in 2019?

What doubts about yourself, your situation, or God do you have that keep you from doing what you are told in Matthew 28:16-20 here locally or globally? What are you doing to address those doubts? (If you could get answers to your questions or doubts, would you then do what you are called to do?)

Does God believe your doubts remove you from the call to follow after Him? If the answer is no it doesn't remove you, how could your doubts be answered and addressed by obeying and doing what He said?

Would you be willing to ask your small group to pray that God would open doors for you and a friend to go and get involved in a local, national, or international mission in 2019?
