What indicates that social standing is now huge in America? When did it become something you thought about?



Jesus tells a story in Luke 14:1-15 with two fulfillments: present and future. The backdrop of this story is Jesus' promise to host a feast in the kingdom of God. (13:29)

Read 14:1-6. What is the setting? Who, When, What? (1)

The Pharisees were "watching" because they considered themselves the authority on what is "lawful." How does Jesus' miracle and explanation challenge their self-assigned position of importance?

Read 14:7-12 What triggered Jesus' parable? What is at the root of the "guests'" choices? (7) What did Jesus say to do? (8,10) What would this require of them?

What is the promise / principle that Jesus applied? (11)

How did Jesus apply this to who is invited? (12-13)

What is the reward for this humble choice? (14-15)

Who is the host to the kingdom meal? Who is invited? (15)

How does aiming for social standing affect our decisions?

How do Jesus' words in 13-14 reflect God's invitation to His kingdom?

How might Jesus' story about including people change us?
