LEARN FROM THE BIBLE

Read 1 Peter 4:1-11. Consider the following questions.

In verses 1-2, Peter calls us to "arm ourselves with Christ's attitude." How would you describe that attitude? What happens when we do?

How should our new life in Christ contrast with our past life? (2-3) What triggers this new lifestyle? (See also Romans 6:5-7)

How might those without Christ respond to our new "in Christ" lifestyle? (4)

Since we will all die and face judgment, what changes our status before God? How did this come about? (5-6)

In light of the troubles in this world and the coming eternity, how are we to live?(7-9) How does this lifestyle fit both the needs of people and the character of God?

According to verse 10, how is love expressed to one another?

How is God involved in this service? (List the provisions and acts of God)

What is the result of a church family that lives according to 1 Peter 4:1-11?

DISCUSS TOGETHER

This passage describes a lifestyle in contrast to the world. Reread 1 Peter 4:1-11 together. What specific aspects stand out to you?

How does knowing that eternity is coming soon fit into this letter (1 Peter)? How does 4:1-11 help us prepare for eternity?

Do you think that the church of America is fulfilling 1 Peter 4:10? According to verse 11, what are the keys to living this out? What are the results of this service?
