The definition of Greek word "sojourner" – an alien alongside, i.e. A resident foreigner. . . Literally, someone "______" but still with personal relationship with the people in that locale

The definition of Greek word "foreigner" – *pároikos* (from *pará*, "close beside" *oíkos*, "house") – properly, someone living close to others as a *temporary* dweller, i.e. in a specific locale as a non-citizen with ______ rights
