This week, we are going to focus on what it means to be sojourners (someone who is passing through but still in personal relationships with people in that locale). All of the verses you saw above are about US living this truth. We are God's family, His community. We do this together, encouraging and bearing one another's burdens. Third, we grow into this. It takes time for God to mature us, to strengthen us.

So, let's live with the NOTW sticker on our hearts and hands. We're citizens of heaven.
