Throughout the year Trinity members work with Joni & Friends wheelchair ministry, Wheels for the World, to restore and provide wheelchairs to those in need with a goal of providing another 50,000 wheelchairs by the year 2020. Brazil served as the host to the 2016 Olympic and Paralympic Games where athletes from around the world broke barriers of what was thought to be physically possible in sport. While perceptions of people with disabilities are improving, Brazil still has few resources available to meet their practical needs. Nearly 30 million people in the country have a physical disability and many lack affordable mobility equipment. WHEELS FOR THE WORLD | March 6-15, 2020 Medical/Disability Outreach | Estimated Costs: \$1850

Throughout the year Trinity members work with Joni & Friends wheelchair ministry, Wheels for the World, to restore and provide wheelchairs to those in need with a goal of providing another 50,000 wheelchairs by the year 2020. With an area slightly smaller than the state of Massachusetts and a population of over 6 million, El Salvador is the smallest, most densely populated country in Central America. In a land whose name translates to "The Savior", you will have opportunities to share the love and message of our true Savior - Jesus Christ - with those affected by disability. Serving as a seating specialist (physical and operational therapists), mechanic, photographer, or support member, team members will provide wheelchairs and the Gospel message to people in need.



LOFT HOUSE CONSTRUCTION MINISTRY | March 26-29, 2020 Construction and Evangelism Outreach | Estimated Costs: \$150

Trinity Church works in partnership with Hands of Mercy (HOM), a nonprofit organization which seeks to reach people in Mexico with the message of Jesus Christ. This goal is accomplished by providing safe housing for families who live in makeshift shelters. The Trinity Mexico ministry teams support loft house projects with a special March trip designed for families. Trinity families share a weekend of worship and working together at the HoM's Rancho Casitas. The two-story pre-fabricated loft houses which dot the landscape around Ensenada exhibit a visible testimony of Christ's love and provision.



URBAN EXPERIENCE AT UNION RESCUE MISSION | April 3-5 & October 2-4, 2020 Homeless Outreach | Estimated Costs: \$100

Spend two days in the heart of skid row at one of the largest rescue missions in the country. The team will stay on the rooftop of Union Rescue Mission and serve men, women and children experiencing homelessness. Trinity volunteers will prep and serve meals and help clean and paint the mission. While there, volunteers will have an opportunity to learn from men and women with great urban ministry experience, many of whom have graduated from, or are currently in a URM program.

KINGDOM BUILDERS CONSTRUCTION MINISTRY | May 1-3 & September 25-27, 2020 Classroom Construction and Evangelism Outreach | Estimated Costs: \$650

The vision of Kingdom Builders Ministry (KBM) is to build relationships and change lives in poor neighborhoods in Mexico by constructing churches, classrooms and homes and training pastors. Trinity teams comprised of men and women ages 14 and up will work to build classrooms in a low-income area of Tijuana or Rosarito, Mexico. This project is very labor intensive including hammering, painting, lifting, cutting, roofing and other various outdoor tasks. Accommodations are dorms with bunk beds.

GLEANINGS FOR THE HUNGRY | May 3-9, 2020 Hunger Outreach | Estimated Costs: \$300

Gleanings for the Hungry is a ministry of Youth With a Mission (YWAM) and seeks to be a force for providing nutritious food for feeding programs in the US and abroad. Gleanings takes donations of undersize or misshapen fruit and vegetables from the surrounding farms. They process them into dried fruits and soup mix and then use them to feed the hungry in the US and various parts of the world. Volunteers at Gleanings will help with this process by packaging soup mix, fixing drying trays, working in the quilt room, helping in the kitchen, maintenance and other duties.



EVANGELICAL FREE CHURCH OF JAPAN | May 28-June 7, 2020 Relational Outreach | Estimated Costs: \$2650

Though Japan is one of the most developed nations on earth, it still remains one of the least reached with less than 1% of its population proclaiming to be followers of Christ. To date five EFCJ churches have requested to partner with Trinity teams for relational outreach during the 2020 summer. The team plans to share the Jesus Film and hopes to reach into the communities in Japan through church partnership, drama programs, youth ministry and conversational English classes.



REACHGLOBAL CRISIS RESPONSE | June 4-15, 2020 Disaster Recovery Construction and Outreach | Estimated Costs: \$975

EFCA church workers from all over the nation travel to the Gulf Coast to aid in the healing of communities with compassionate outreach, evangelism and disciplemaking.



REACHGLOBAL CRISIS RESPONSE | June 20-28, 2020 Disaster Recovery Construction and Outreach | Estimated Costs: \$1325

Join forces with EFCA churches and ReachGlobal partners to help residents of Ocracoke Island and the North Carolina coast continue their recovery after Hurricane Dorian. In the wake of natural disasters. rebuilding takes on a larger holistic meaning. EFCA church workers from all over the nation travel to the North Carolina coast to aid in the healing of communities with compassionate outreach, evangelism and disciplemaking.

Classroom Construction and Evangelism Outreach | Estimated Costs: \$3000 ************************************* This medical mission team will partner with Trinity missionaries David & Lucy Kiamu, and Jasper Williams of Community Church Ministries in Liberia, West Africa to equip a core group of trainers in churches, schools, hospitals and the Liberian Ministry of Health. Training offered will include CPR, first aid and community health clinics. The team will also be involved in showing the Jesus Film in local villages outside of Monrovia. This project will serve as a platform for members of Trinity to reach our world by helping to heal the sick and serve the broken hearted.

Youth, Sports and English Outreach | Estimated Costs: \$2300 The HSM mission team will partner with Trinity missionaries Jonathan & Tracy Shoemaker this summer in Portugal. The Shoemakers are involved in church planting ministry in Lisbon. The team will be a support with two local church plants to reach their communities with the Gospel. HSM students will use their gifts to minister to children through leading crafts, Bible stories, games and sports. They will also partner with local churches to assist in outreach initiatives, which may include English language outreach.



ENGLISH FELLOWSHIP CHURCH | July 3-13 ESL and Children's Program | Estimated Costs: \$1800

Trinity missionaries Jeremy & Sara McMillan are leading a church of like-minded Jesus followers who reach out to the community with a wide array of programs focused on physical, social and spiritual enrichment. The team will lead English outreach programs in the evenings and can work with local children or participate in partner programs for orphans and feeding those in need. There will also be an opportunity to work on light construction projects in the church offices and classrooms.



Minister to Women Global Workers | Estimated Costs: \$1995 Thrive hosts retreats worldwide allowing Global Women a place for refreshment, encouragement and holistic healing. The Colorado retreat draws women who are in the states on home assignment. Many attendees work in remote locations without contact with other believers and are in much need for rest and a space to process how God is working in their lives. Retreats take place at a conference center or hotel. Like-minded volunteers are needed to provide an environment for physical, spiritual, and emotional renewal by providing holistic care and sharing in worship and prayer. While there are several roles that require particular skills and training (worship leaders, counselors, hair stylists, massage therapists, etc.), they primarily need women who are willing to serve in any way possible to extend love and grace to the attendees!
